

Weather Interruption Policy

If weather (rain or lightning) creates unsafe conditions and prevents an ongoing match from concluding during the scheduled time, the following policy will be in effect:

RAINOUT: The Recreation Department will email players by 4:00pm if there is a RAINOUT. If no email is issued by 4:00pm, players will make game time decision regarding weather.

Unsafe conditions can be determined by team captains or players.

If weather stops play after the first set has been concluded, the match will be rescheduled before the next scheduled league match for either team.

If weather stops play after the first set has been concluded and fewer than five games of the second set have been played, the winner of the first set wins the match.

If weather stops play after five games of the second set have been concluded, the team that won the greatest number of games in both sets wins the match. If each team has the same number of games won, the winner of the first set wins the match.

If all players can agree to a time and place to conclude the weather interrupted match before either team is scheduled to play another league match, the above policy is waived.
